




A DEDICATION TO CRAFTING EXQUISITE CABERNET SAUVIGNON.

Today Louis M. Martini offers a carefully curated selection of Napa Valley's finest Cabernet Sauvignon crafted by our winemaker, Michael Eddy. He brings his passion to the winery as just the fourth winemaker in our history. Our flagship Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is sourced from revered Napa Valley vineyards and is a superbly balanced representation of the appellation's preeminent varietal. While our Crown Cabernets are site specific wines sourced from individual Napa Valley vineyards. The absolute pinnacle of our portfolio is Lot No. 1, which is selected annually from our most coveted vineyards. It's Cabernet Sauvignon at its peak form of expression.



OUR HISTORY



1899

At age 12, Louis M. Martini travels from Genoa, Italy, to the United States to join his father in San Francisco.

1906

After making wine with his father, Louis M. returns to Italy to study winemaking.

1922

L.M. Martini Grape Products Company is established, focusing on sacramental wine and concentrate for home winemaking during Prohibition.

1933

Louis M. builds his winery in Napa Valley, anticipating the repeal of Prohibition. The winery secures its bond on September 19, 1933.

1936

The winery is one of the first to use cold fermentation.

1938

Louis M. purchases the Goldstein Ranch and renames it Monte Rosso Vineyard.

1943

Louis M. helps establish the Napa Valley Vintners Association with the aim of developing and promoting the quality of Napa Valley wines worldwide.

1951

Louis P. Martini, son of Louis M., introduces the use of wind machines to prevent frost in the vineyards.

1954

Louis P. is given full responsibility as winemaker.

1968

Louis P. is among the first to bottle a varietal Merlot in California.

1977

Upon graduation from UC Davis, Mike Martini takes over as winemaker.

1994

The Louis P. Martini endowment for Viticulture and Enological Research is established at UC Davis.

2002

The Gallo family, close friends of the Martini family for three generations, purchases the winery and vineyards.

2003

Cellar No. 254 is completed to focus on small-lot productions.

2008

Louis P. Martini is inducted into the Vintner's Hall of Fame as a "Pioneer," recognized for his significant contributions to the California wine industry.

2016

Michael Eddy, who spent a decade under the tutelage of Mike Martini, is named winemaker.

2017


The 2013 Lot No. 1 is awarded a 100-point score by The Wine Advocate.

2019

A restoration of the original winery is completed, introducing an array of world-class tasting experiences.

A PURSUIT OF THE BEST MOUNTAIN VINEYARDS.

For over 85 years we have sought out the most coveted mountain vineyards in Napa Valley. It started with Monte Rosso, high up in the Mayacama Mountains and known for its rugged terrain. Purchased in 1938, the vineyard dates back much further and was originally planted in the 1800's. Today it continues to produce red varietals of unmistakable minerality and acidity from its famous soil. Our quest for the best vineyards in the mountains around Napa Valley is ongoing and recently resulted in our acquisition of Atlas Peak's Stagecoach Vineyard. It's one of the world's most coveted vineyards known for its robust blocks of mountain fruit and has been a blending component in our Lot 1 wines for years. The perfect way to taste the unique character of our most esteemed vineyards, including Monte Rosso, Stagecoach, Howell Mountain, and Cypress Ranch, is with our Crown Cabernet collection, which is dedicated to single vineyard releases.
